

Safe Environment Training

The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study or participate in church-sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY length of time are required to attend the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshop. If you plan to work with the Religious Ed. Program, RCIC, Children's Church, Youth Ministry or any other program involving children and youth this year or in the future, you MUST attend this training at least once. It is advisable to arrive 15 minutes prior to workshop start time to complete paperwork. Attendees must remain present the entire 2 hour presentation and complete completion paperwork at the end.
