Mowing Season

Please note during mowing season at both St. Mary and St. Theresa Cemeteries, no benches, flower arrangements, statues, or any other objects are cemetery permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing

or weed-eating of the cemetery. Shepherds hooks are acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements hanging from them don't interfere with mowing/weed-eating. Small statues or any other objects placed on the base of a monument must be glued to the base St. Mary Magdalen of Pazzi number is EG238 so they don't end up on the ground. Please note that when St. Theresa number is LU282 flower arrangements get blown off a grave due to winds, we have no way of knowing which grave they came from.
