# Mowing Season



Please note during mowing season at both St. Mary and St. Theresa Cemeteries, no benches, flower arrangements, statues, or any other objects are cemetery permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing

parishes. Also, high school seniors have until May acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements hanging from them don't interfere with mowing/weed-eating.
