"None of us lives for oneself, and no one dies for The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that oneself. For if we live, we live for the Lord, and if children and youth who worship, study or participate in church we die, we die for the Lord; so the, whether we live sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY lengthy of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops. At this time, the trainings are limited to 50 individuals. All trainings are first come/first served. No advance registration is necessary.
