Fraud Alert - Covid-19 Vaccine Scams

With the distribution of vaccines for COVID-19 now underway, it is important to be aware of scams seeking to take advantage of the elderly and other vulnerable people. Seniors should be particularly vigilant for callers, texters, or visitors seeking money or their private information in order to receive the vaccine.

The United States Department of Health and Human Services issued these tips to protect yourself from fraud.

- You will NOT be asked for money to improve your ranking 1. for vaccine eligibility.
- Government and State officials will NOT call you to obtain personal information in order to receive the vaccine, and you will NOT be solicited door to door to receive the vaccine.
- Medicare will NOT contact you to offer you COVID-19 3. related products.
- 4. Do NOT respond to or open any text messages or hyperlinks from unknown senders.
- 5. Be suspicious of any unexpected calls or visitors offering vaccinations, tests or supplies.

Safe Environment Training

The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study or participate in church sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or **youth** (18 and under) for ANY lengthy of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops. At this time, the trainings are limited to 25 individuals. All trainings are first come/first served. No advance registration is necessary. The next scheduled are:
