Safe Environment Refresher Training



The Archdiocese requires that all employees and volunteers who have regular contact with minors such as youth leaders, chaperones, catechist, aides, etc. **MUST ATTEND** an in-person Safe Environment workshop offered by the Archdiocese of Louisville. If it has been over 5 years since you received your in-person Safe Environment Training, you must now complete a five year refresher training online or attend an in-person Safe Environment Training. If you would like to receive the online refresher training, instructions from CMG Connect are available in the back of church or you may pick up a copy at the office or from the DRE.
