Payneville Elementary School will have Kindergarten registration on Monday, March 4, 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Please bring your student and plan on attending the entire evening. Student must be 5 years old on or before August 1 of the 2024 school year.

The **following items are required** for your student to start the school year. Please bring what you can to registration.

- ★**Proof of Residency**-2 proofs required (Ex. Utility bill, driver's license)
- ★**Medical Exam Form** - School Physical
- ★**Vision Exam** - Certified Optometrist exam
- ★**Dental Exam**
- ★**Birth Certificate** - official state copy
- ★**Immunization Certificate** - must be a current/up-to-date certificate for Kentucky
- ★**Social Security Card**
