In an effort to fulfill this commitment, **all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY lengthy of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops.** No one under the age of 17 will be admitted, including infants. **All trainings are first come/first served.
