More than 106,000 individuals and families have sought federal disaster aid. We can support our brothers and sisters in Louisiana through monetary donations to Catholic Charities, who will provide emergency and long-term disaster assistance. It is a Roman Catholic Mass, but a warm invitation is extended to all of those working in the legal profession.

Workers and Volunteers for Mercy and Catechists

During this year of Mercy, the month of September brings together both the corporal and spiritual works of mercy as we observe two special events: the **canonization of Mother Teresa of Calcutta on September 4th**, who embodies for the world of corporal works of mercy and **Catechetical Sunday on September 18** when we honor those teachers and catechists who instruct people at all stages of life by teaching and sharing our faith. Pope Francis' message to catechists at an audience in 2013 is instructive for both groups: "But Jesus did not say, 'Go and make do,' he said, 'Go, I am with you...'. This is our beauty and our strength: If we go, if we go out to bring his Gospel with love, with real apostolic spirit, with (confidence), he walks with us, goes before us." Please keep all who work for mercy and teach the faith in your prayers.
