Catholic Relief Services



Did you know that 25% of our Rice Bowl and Catholic Relief Services donations benefits organizations right here in our Archdiocese?

Here are those who received CRS grants in 2016...

Feeding America, Kentucky's Heartland used their grant to help provide weekend food for those children who without the availability of school meals might go hungry.

Saint Vincent de Paul replaced an aging roof for their Ozanam Inn, a men's homeless shelter with 58 emergency, overnight bunk beds for men who would otherwise be on the streets

Saint John's Center for Homeless Men used their grant funds for client transportation (TARC passes), outpatient health services (co-pays for appointments), moving expenses for men moving into housing, Life Skills classes, apartment application fees, case management, and overhead costs.

Franciscan Kitchen used the grant money to pray for the green beans purchased for their daily meals, which will feed 7,650 people.

The Cathedral ID Program has helped 77 individuals to date to obtain a Kentucky State Identification Card.
