Mowing Season Begins Soon

During mowing season at both St. Mary and St. Theresa Cemeteries, no flower arrangements, statues, benches, or other objects are permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing or weed-eating of the cemetery. Shepherd hooks are acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements hanging from them don't interfere with mowing/weed-eating. Small statues or any other small objects placed on the base of a monument must be glued to the base so they don't end up on the ground. Please note that when flower arrangements get blown off a grave due to winds, we have no way of knowing which grave they came from.
