In Light of Covid-19 Virus

*Priests, Deacons, ministers of Holy Communion and Altar Servers must always wash hands before Mass begins, and they should use an alcohol based anti-bacterial solution of at least 60% alcohol before and after distributing Holy Communion.

*We have removed holy water to avoid spread of illness.

*All vessels used at Mass, once purified, are thoroughly washed with soap and hot water after each use.

*Avoid physical contact - give nod or wave instead of shaking hands during the sign of peace, Do not hold hands during the Our Father.

*Please remember that communicable illness is a valid reason not to attend Mass. For those parishioners that are ill and must miss Mass, Mass of the Air is available on WHAS-TV, channel 11, at 10:30 a.m. each Sunday.
