Latest Info Concerning Liturgies



Beginning Wednesday, May 20th, we will resume Masses at St. Mary and St. Theresa with the regular weekly schedule. Archbishop Kurtz has issued a dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days until further notice. Anyone

who is sick or living with someone who is sick should stay home, as should anyone who feels vulnerable. During the initial period of reopening, all parishioners are asked to wear a mask or face covering when attending Mass. No one will be turned away because they are not wearing a mask. Masks can be removed while receiving communion. Everyone is asked to wash their hands thoroughly before coming to Mass and after using the restroom. To allow for social distancing, every other pew will be blocked off. One family unit may gather in each pew. Others are asked to stay minimum of six feet apart. Seating will be limited but with the Gathering Space at St. Mary and the Choir Loft at St. Theresa we are hoping to accommodate everyone.

Please note: One of the main criteria for reopening the churches is the ability to clean it between masses. We are trying to form a committee to take care of this. Please call or email the parish office if you can help wipe down pews, light switches, counter tops, etc. after Mass.

Mowing Season



Please note during mowing season at both St. Mary and St. Theresa Cemeteries, no benches, flower arrangements, statues, or any other objects are permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing or weed-eating of the cemetery. Shepherds hooks are acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements hanging from them don't interfere with mowing/weed-eating. Small statues or any other objects placed on the base of a monument must be glued to the base so they don't end up on the ground. Please note that when flower arrangements get blown off a grave due to winds, we have no way of knowing which grave they came from.
