Payneville Elementary School will have Kindergarten Registration on **Tuesday, March 15**, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. Student must be 5 years old on or before August 1 of the 2022 school year. The following items are required for your student to start the school year. Please bring what you can to registration.

- *Proof of Residency - 2 proofs required (Ex. Utility bill & driver's license)
- *Medical Exam Form - School Physical
- *Vision Exam - Certified Optometrist exam
- *Dental Exam
- *Birth Certificate - official state copy
- *Immunization Certificate - must be a current/up to date certificate for Kentucky
