Safe Environment Training - The Archdiocese requires anyone working with children & youth of the parish to attend a Safe Environment Training. Deanna is making arrangements to have a training at St. Mary this fall. If you are working with, or plan to work with, children & youth as a catechist, children's church teacher, youth volunteer or chaperone, teacher's aid, vacation bible school volunteer or in any other way. Please watch for date and time so that you can attend this training.

Safe Environment "Refresher" Training - Last November, Archbishop Kurtz sent out a letter announcing the new five year Safe Environment "Refresher" Training requirement. The refresher is for staff and volunteers who attended their initial Safe Environment training over 5 years prior and needs to be completed before the end of 2022. The refresher can be done online or at any of the scheduled in person trainings, only **AFTER** a member has completed an **initial IN PERSON** training.
