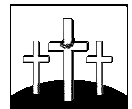

Lent is a season marked by penitential practices, such as abstinence from eating meat on Fridays during Lent. It sometimes happens that during the Lenten season certain feasts occur that prompt a decision to exempt from the usual penitential practices. One such day is the memorial of St. Patrick, which falls on Friday, March 17.

I therefore grant that on Friday, March 17, 2023, all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Louisville, and all other Catholics actually present in the Archdiocese on that day, are dispensed from the obligation (can.87§1). With my prayers that the season of Lent will be a time of spiritual renewal and conversion for us all, I remain,

Mowing Season

Mowing season will begin soon in our cemeteries. Any arrangements or decorations on the ground will be removed in the next couple weeks. During mowing season at both St. Mary and St Theresa Cemeteries, no benches, flower arrangements, statues, or any other objects are permitted on the ground that will interfere with mowing or weed-eating of the cemetery. Shepherds hooks are acceptable only if they are placed right next to the monument and the arrangements hanging on them don't interfere with mowing/weed-eating. Small statues or any other objects placed on the base of the monument must be glued to the base so they don't end up on the ground. Please note with flower arrangements get blown off due to high winds, we have no way of knowing which grave they belong to.
