According to one Code Officer of the Meade County Planning and Zoning Department: “We sometimes had a violator who received a citation, and the violator often expressed a need for assistance in cleaning the garbage/rubbish from their property to come into compliance. The violator also stated that they cannot afford the fines associated with the citation, let alone pay for help with the cleaning up. Please remember that the primary objective of code enforcement is to obtain voluntary compliance with the ordinances as opposed to punitive action.”

I, Jess Mills, am a lifetime member of St. Martin of Tours in Flaherty and also a member of the newly formed Code Enforcement Board. The Board has the authority to reduce or even eliminate fines associated with a citation. If a dumpster is needed, it is usually supplied at no cost. What we do not have is a sufficient number of volunteers who can help clean up. We have volunteers who mow grass for individuals who are incapable of performing the task and who probably cannot afford to pay for that service.
