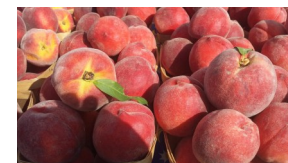

St. Theresa Picnic & Auction is Saturday, August 8

Raffle tickets - Raffle tickets for the picnic are available beginning this weekend. You can get them at the back of church before or after mass. You can also pick them up at the Parish Office on Tuesday and Thursday between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm. Please return your tickets and money in the provided envelope. You can drop them in the collection no later than August 2 or bring them by the Parish Office during normal working hours.

Auction items - Auction items are needed. They can be new or like new, handmade items, antiques, gift baskets, home-baked specialty cakes, etc. No "yard sale" items please. Please get all items turned in by August 4th so they can be included on the hand bill, which is vital to the Auctioneer and the smooth flow of the auction. If you're unable to physically bring the item in by August 4th, please ensure Karen has a photo and information on item, so she can include in the hand bill. Meat Collection - We will have a second collection the whole month of July to offset the cost of the meat for the picnic. Thank you in advance for your donations.

St. Mary Parish Hall Rental

Effective July 1, the fees for the rental of St. Mary's Parish Hall will change. All renters will be required to purchase insurance thru the Archdiocese at \$95 per event. This will be a \$1,000,000 liability policy and is mandatory per the Archdiocese. Parishioners will pay \$50 per day plus a \$50 deposit. Non-parishioners will pay \$100 per day plus a \$100 deposit. All deposits will be refunded pending inspection by the parish staff. All fees must be paid upon scheduling the hall and must be done no later than one month prior to event. If the event is cancelled and the insurance policy has been requested, the \$95 insurance fee will not be refunded. If it is more than two weeks prior to the event, the rental fee and deposit will be refunded. Please contact the parish office if you have any additional questions.
