Food Drive

Food & grocery items have been collected each month for the Meade County Food Pantry and our Blessing Box. Starting the week of July 6th, we will have a box set up in each church that will allow folks to bring donations at their convenience. The items will be collected and used for the Blessing Box at St. Mary's or the Food Pantry. Please feel free to drop off at the parish offices during normal business hours as well. Any donation of food and groceries are very much appreciated; however, please check the dates to make sure the food hasn't expired.



St. Mary Parish Hall Rental

Effective July 1, the fees for the rental of St. Mary's Parish Hall will change. All renters will be required to purchase insurance thru the Archdiocese at \$95 per event. This will be a \$1,000,000 liability policy and is mandatory per the Archdiocese. Parishioners will pay \$50 per day plus a \$50 deposit. Non-parishioners will pay \$100 per day plus a \$100 deposit. All deposits will be refunded pending inspection by the parish staff. All fees must be paid upon scheduling the hall and must be done no later than one month prior to event. If the event is cancelled and the insurance policy has been requested, the \$95 insurance fee will not be refunded. If it is more than two weeks prior to the event, the rental fee and deposit will be refunded. Please contact the parish office if you have any additional questions.
